Brenham ISD Block Party - Each year Brenham ISD hosts a community-wide block party in October. During this event, each campus offers a booth with age-appropriate activities for students, and the Brenham ISD central office serves sausages-on-a-stick to attendees. This event is hosted in partnership with several local organizations and is made possible by many generous sponsors. Watch D.O.G.S. - The Watch D.O.G.S. (Dads of Great Students) national family & community engagement program was brought to Brenham ISD upon recommendation from the district safety task force. Watch D.O.G.S. may read with students, play at recess, eat lunch with students, watch school entrances and hallways, assist with traffic flow and any other assigned activities where they actively engage with not only their own students but other students as well. This program allows students to gain positive male role models, schools to gain an extra set of eyes and ears, and fathers to get a glimpse of their students' everyday world.

Game Changers - Brenham Game Changers are a group of people who are willing to change their attitudes to make a difference in the lives of other people. Brenham Game Changers support the efforts of making a difference in teachers and students' lives with professional training, character building clubs and endless opportunities to serve fellow classmates and the community at large.
