BISD Advanced Academics Expo

Spring 2019 Gifted & Talented Testing

K-12 students may participate in the GT nomination, assessment, screening and identification process. BISD screens students for the GT program using a multi-criteria approach to selection with 3 phases of placement. GT identification is based upon data collected from achievement tests, ability tests, parent and teacher observation surveys, and student products from Kingore Planned Experiences.

**If the student has been previously nominated and not identified as G/T, please write a note on the form explaining when your child was originally tested. Screening is only available to students who were not screened during the 2018-19 school year.*
