Policy for Brenham ISD Student Athletes

The basic principle of conduct under which athletes will operate at Brenham ISD is to conduct yourself in such a manner that you bring credit to yourself, your teammates, your family and to Brenham ISD. Never engage in any activity that can be construed as inappropriate for a Brenham ISD athletic team member.

- How we present ourselves is extremely important.
 - Always present ourselves in a manner of the highest class.
 - No facial hair.
 - No unusual piercings (nose, eyebrow, etc).
 - For males: hair will not extend beyond the eyebrows or beyond the collar of the shirt.
 - For males: No earring(s).
- A commitment to Brenham Athletics requires that school contests and practices are the priority over any non-school contest or practice.
- Always be on time to practices, games and for travel arrangements.
- Adhere to the Brenham ISD Student Code of Conduct.
- If you must miss athletics, talk to your coach prior to missing the workout to discuss the consequences that will be required.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. The decision will be made by each individual coach as to the consequences for such.
- Stealing from your teammates, or from other schools, is unacceptable and is punishable by suspension from the team.
- Athletes will not be in possession of or consume alcohol, tobacco, or other illegal drugs.
- Athletes who quit a team mid-season will not be allowed to join another sport until the sport they quit finishes the season, without approval from both coaches involved.
- Athletes are required to maintain a passing GPA to be eligible for competition. Coaches for each sport regularly check athlete's grades.
- Telecommunication devices
 - Use may not in any way:
 - Disrupt the educational process in the District
 - Endanger the health or safety of the student or anyone else
 - Invade the rights of others at school
 - Involve illegal or prohibited conduct of any kind
 - Specifically, the use of a cell phone or any device that may be used to take pictures, capture images, or video any locker room, bathroom or other areas in which students dress is prohibited.

Disciplinary Action:

- Serious infraction to these policies could result in dismissal from your current team, or from all other Brenham ISD athletic teams.
